Background:

Kurt grew up in the Midwest and built big like his dad. Had a sensitive side like Mom. Around 13 he started exhibiting huge psychic abilities. Got the attention of an entity who started to plague and torment him at night. Dad kept telling him it was imagination and never believed him. Kurt lived in fear for two years' worth of torment. This thing would appear in his room and creep closer, messing with him. Kurt accidentally lashed out one night as it climbed onto his bed. His power hurt this entity. While it drove it off for a time, it came back and started messing with things around the house. Kurt's dad blamed him for things going on, broken vases, cracked mirrors, moved furniture and what not. Took it out on Kurt.

Kept escalating and at fifteen, Kurt knew the entity was still around and went on the hunt for it. He'd been testing his skills and tried to attack it. He managed to drive it back, but it retaliated. During the night their house caught on fire. Kurt got out, but mom and dad died of smoke inhalation.

However, something about the energy from Alaska started bothering Kurt. Nosebleeds and headaches and eventually he had to leave. Riker stayed and they left on so-so terms but he understands her.

Kurt was asked to join another team in the states and they paired him with Cassidy Garret and three others. Cassidy has a lot more diplomacy but she also understands Kurt. Those two get along well too—not the same as Kurt and Riker's relationship, but Kurt would kill for Cass. He's stomped into highly dangerous situations more than once to protect Cass.
